(p. 123)</p> <p>* T asks Ss to read the text again and extract some ideas for their writing, <i>e.g. walk, cycle or use public transport.</i></p> <p>** Ss complete the task individually and write a paragraph (120 – 150 words), then swap their paragraphs for peer review with a partner.</p> <p>*** T gives Ss enough time to complete the paragraph. T sets a time limit depending on the Ss' ability level.</p> <p>**** T asks individual Ss to read their paragraphs or collects them to check after class and provides written feedback.</p> <p><i>Sample answer:</i></p> <p><i>There are several things that we should do to reduce the negative impact of travelling on the environment. Firstly, we should reduce our carbon footprint during the trip. We should only fly when the trip is long and choose environmentally-friendly means of transport such as cycling or public transport. Secondly, wherever we go, we should always protect our environment.
